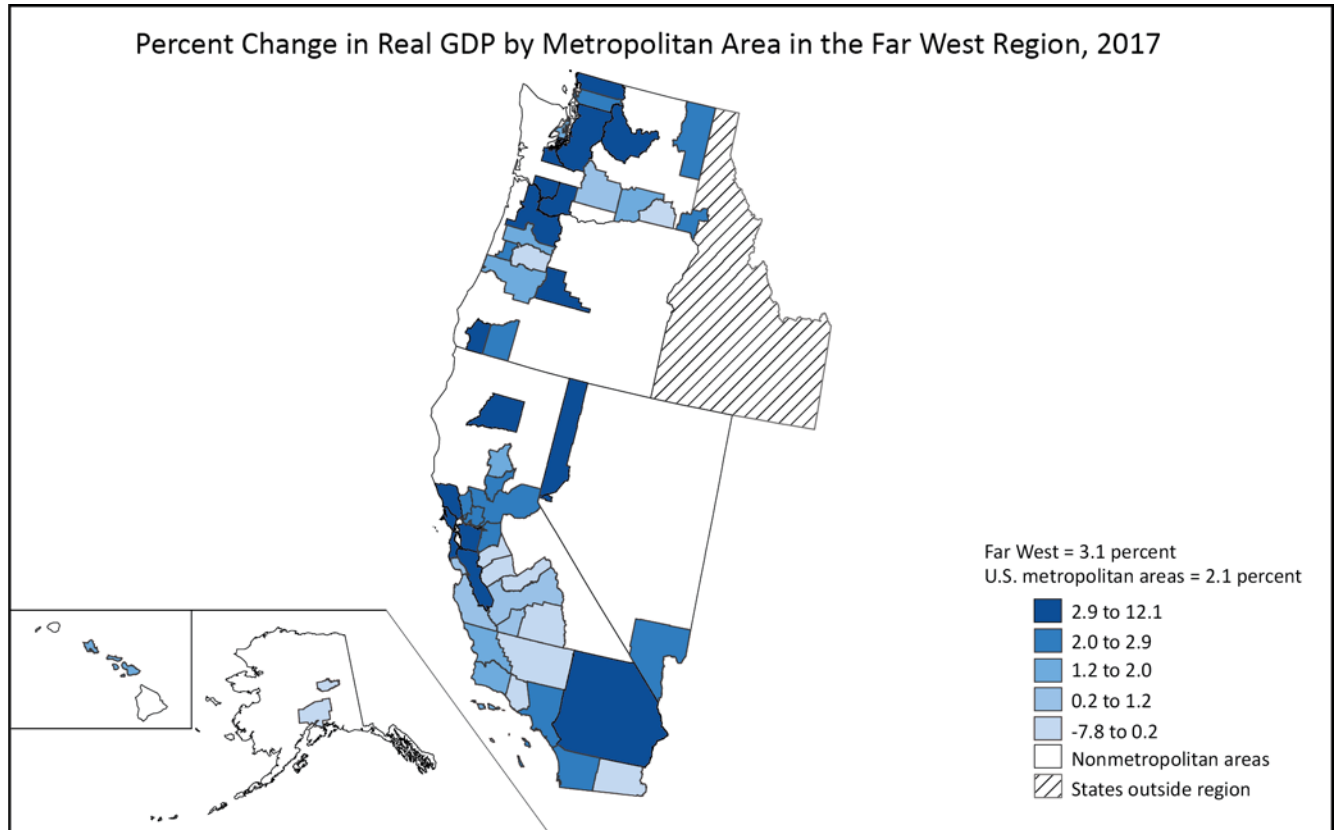


Gross Domestic Product (GDP) by Metropolitan Area, 2017

- Real GDP increased in 41 of the 52 MSAs wholly contained in this region. Growth in real GDP ranged from 7.6 percent to -6.6 percent.
- Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim, CA—the largest metropolitan area in the region, and the 2nd largest in the nation—increased 2.8 percent due to growth in information services. San Francisco-Oakland-Hayward, CA—the 2nd largest metropolitan area in the region, and the 6th largest in the nation—increased 3.4 percent due to growth in information services.
- Per capita real GDP in the MSAs wholly contained in this region ranged from \$128,308 in San Jose-Sunnyvale-Santa Clara, CA to \$25,093 in Grants Pass, OR.
