Recommendations Summary

Focus Area Highlights

OMB should:

- issue guidance and regulations required or expected under the Evidence Act
- designate a full-time Chief Statistician of the United States
- establish a clear procedure for public and stakeholder engagement on future data standards
- issue a memorandum clarifying expectations on use of existing authorities and flexibilities to facilitate data sharing and use
- develop legislative proposals to expanded access to income and earnings data already acquired by federal agencies
- develop legislative proposals to test and pilot emerging approaches to protecting data

Greatest Successes and Challenges

Focus Area Discussion

Greatest successes

- Increased appreciation of state efforts to make data available for evidence building
- Confirmation of the Commission's recommendations and exceptional insight
- Finding that existing authorities are not fully employed or supported with OMB guidance

Greatest challenges

- Navigating the gauntlet of laws and rules at all levels of government
- Increasing Congressional confidence that privacy will be protected if additional authorities are granted
